A TIME OF REFLECTION

"The Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost." Luke 19:10 (ESV) encapsulates this biography of Christ with this quotation.

Luke was a doctor, a friend of Theophilus and a well-educated Greek. He wrote the Book of Acts and has been credited with also writing Luke. His writing evidences a great vocabulary, sometimes even in classical Greek literary style, along with excellent research. He wrote most likely from Rome when Paul was incarcerated, and sent to Antioch, Achaia and / or Ephesus. The authorship date is somewhat fuzzy, from 59–80 AD, but it is generally accepted as part of the earliest canon of Scripture. Luke recounts 28 parables, 20 miracles and more about the Holy Spirit than the other three Gospels. His purpose of presenting Jesus as the Messiah is evident throughout and especially in the verse quoted above.

Luke followed this chronology:

Chapters 1-9: Jesus' birth and the events in and around Galilee.

Chapters 10-19: Events in and around Judea and Perea.

Chapters 20-24: Jesus' discourses and the events in Jerusalem.

Aside from the canonical information, Luke's skill with a pen and vocabulary makes the ministry of Jesus live in reality no matter what the century. Matthew wrote to the Hebrews in Rome. Mark wrote to the Greeks, and Luke wrote to the world. Is the story the same? No. More parables. More miracles. More discourses. Yes. Same crucifixion. Same resurrection. Same commission. Same promise to return. Luke definitely belongs. Here is how he begins his Gospel in 1:1-4 (ESV):

Inasmuch as many have undertaken to compile a narrative of the things that have been accomplished among us, just as those who from the beginning were eyewitnesses and ministers of the Word have delivered them to us, it seemed good to me also, having followed all things closely for some time past, to write an orderly account for you, most excellent Theophilus, that you may have certainty concerning the things you have been taught.
